All **quizzes** are conducted in Canvas outside of class time, and **due at 11:59 pm** on the day listed. They are all open on the first day of class, and you may take them before the due date. The quizzes are not timed; however, at the moment they are due, they will submit even if you are in the middle of a question.

All **exams** are conducted on Canvas in our classroom **during class** time. Once you start an exam, you will have 40 minutes to complete it. Exams will automatically submit 40 minutes after starting. You must bring two devices to class on exam days: one that works with the LockDown Browser in Canvas and another that handles DUO authentication. Exams are open-note (including your class notes and PowerPoints), but you can only use printed copies. You will not be allowed to access any digital document during the time you're taking an exam. You may NOT use your textbook during the exam. Exam 0 is a practice exam (i.e., not graded) that allows you to download the LockDown Browser software and verify everything works.
